

ANNUAL CATHOLIC APPEAL Second Half of the Year Ramp -Up

43 Families and individuals from our Parish have contributed to ACA 2025-2026 That's 23.5% of our members here in Dillon. Together we've raised over \$23,227.48 which is 97.14% of our \$24,000 GOAL! Even though we are almost 100% on meeting our financial goal for the Parish, we are far below the participation goal for the Diocese.. If everyone at St. Rose signed up and gave even \$5, we may exceed the Diocesan overall goal of 17% participation.






