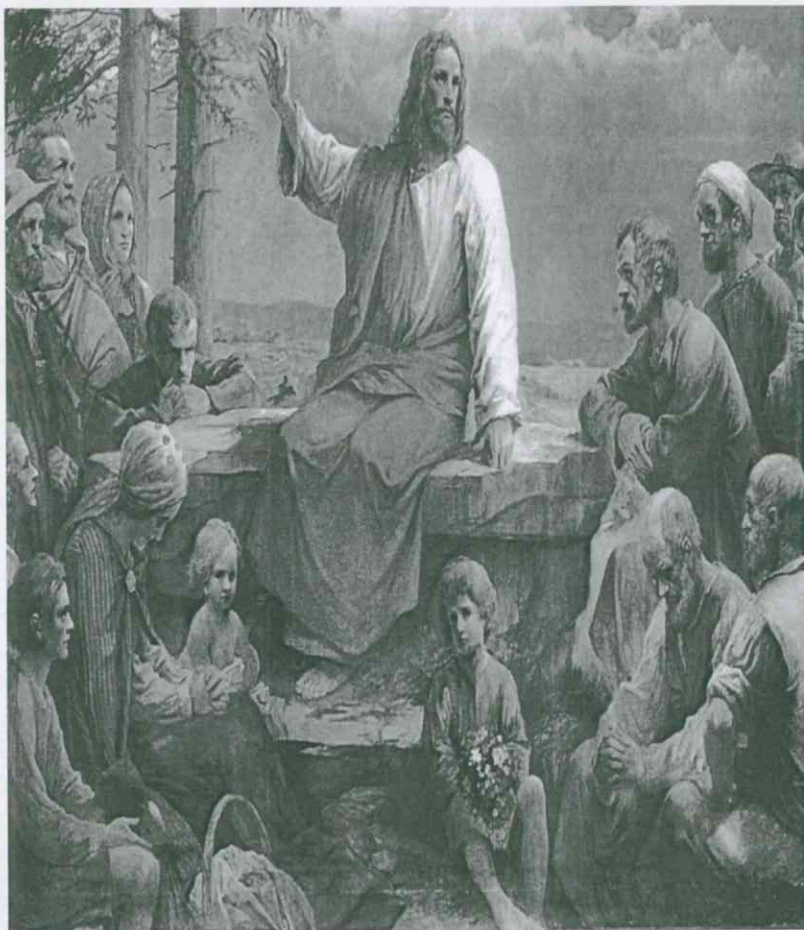

Tax Smart Ways to Make A Gift!

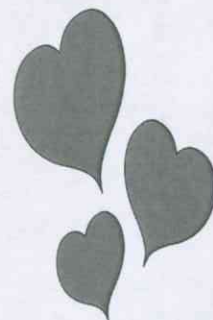
