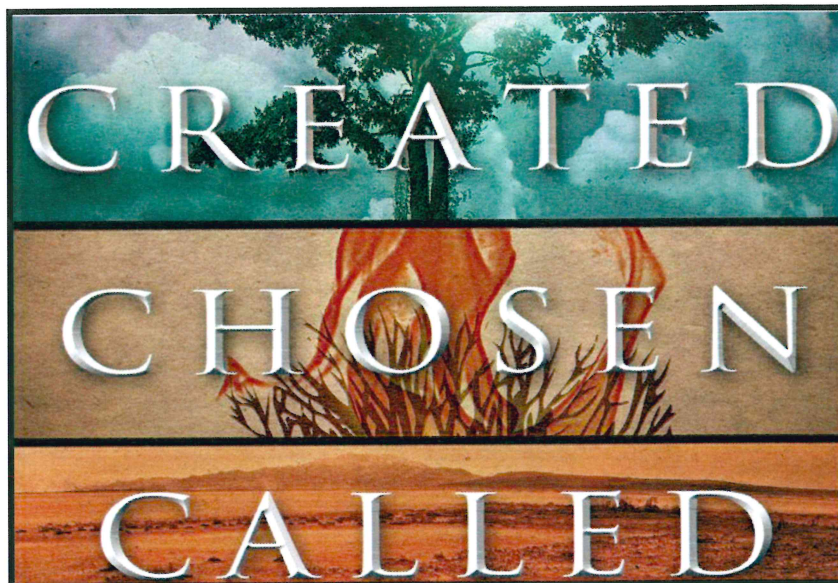

Kitchen remodel, new utilities, utensil storage carts

Large room remodel, new floor surface, Family Center women's bathroom, storage room installations, new tables and carts, and the current roof was temporarily re-nailed.

Church:
