SACRAMENTAL LIFE

2. All those who are Baptized and have not yet completed the Sacrament of Confirmation are invited to register by calling or emailing the Parish Office.
3. Baptisms of children (0-6 years) occur after one month of preparation. Parents and Godparents are required to attend class prior to the celebration of the Sacrament of Baptism.
4. The preparation for the Sacrament of Marriage lasts six months. If you are contemplating celebrating a wedding, please keep this in mind. Life is beautiful when the covenant is made forever before our Good Lord.

Daily Reflections by Catherine Upchurch

No More Wishful Thinking

Readings: 1 Cor 15:1-8; John 14:6-14

Scripture: “Amen, amen, I say to you, whoever believes in me will do the works that I do, and will do greater ones than these, because I am *going* to the Father.” (John 14:12)

Reflection: I’ve heard people say that they wish they lived in Israel at the time of Jesus’ ministry so they could have witnessed for themselves how he taught and healed. Then, they say, *then* they could believe in him. Of course, we might remind them that even those who were with Jesus daily didn’t always “get it.” In fact, we might be at an advantage because we have been given the gift of the Spirit and two thousand years of living witnesses.

On some level, today’s Gospel addresses that sense of wishful thinking. Jesus and his apostles are gathered in Jerusalem, sharing their final meal together, and there is undoubtedly a sense of foreboding in the air. Judas has been identified as the one who will betray Jesus, and Peter as the one who will deny knowing him. Jesus uses this time to settle their troubled hearts with words of encouragement about the essential role they will play in continuing the works of Jesus.

In fact, Jesus tells his followers something that would sound scandalous if it were not attributed to Jesus himself: they will do even greater works than he did! How can this be? Jesus will share with them (and with us) the unity he has with the Father, and he will send the Spirit as a sign of his continuing presence with them. The Acts of the Apostles is filled with instances of the work of the living Jesus continuing in and through the earliest generation of believers. Christian history gives us further testimony that God is still doing wonderful things among us.

Meditation: When has wishful thinking prevented you from living in the present moment and recognizing its potential? “If I had only seen…” or “If God had only…” Ironically, by wishing things had been different in the past, we can fail to make a difference in the now. Let’s invite God’s gift of the Spirit to help us give witness to where God is at work today.

Prayer: O God whose mercy endures, may we find you at work in our words and deeds so that we truly become the living Body of Christ.
