

2. All those who are Baptized and have not yet completed the Sacrament of Confirmation are invited to register by calling or emailing the Parish Office.
3. Baptisms of children (0-6 years) occur after 9 preparation sessions. Parents are required to attend class prior to the celebration of the Sacrament of Baptism of their 1st child.
