Deposit and Loan Restoration Trust

Good news! The Deposit and Loan Restoration Trust that was set up as part of the bankruptcy plan has made an initial distribution of 3% to the entities who held deposits in the Deposit and Loan Fund at the Diocese at the time of the bankruptcy in 2014.

The D&L Guild Flower Arrangements Fund for St. Rose of Lima Parish - Dillon, contains \$2,859.57. Therefore, the first pay-out received is \$85.79.

The D&L Long Term Reserve Fund for St. Rose of Lima Parish - Dillon, contains \$30,335.26. Therefore, the first pay-out received is \$910.06.

The D&L Melrose Mission Fund for St. Rose of Lima Parish - Melrose contains \$67,553.03. Therefore, the first pay-out received is \$2,026.59.
