

Parish Registration!

For Parish Members who need to update household information or for folks who have not registered with St. Rose of Lima, please use one of the following options to update your information or register!

- 1. Pick up a registration form in the back of church. One form per household member. Fill them out and return them to the church office or through the collection basket.
- 2. Download the Camino Life App onto your phone and create an account. From there, you can register your household with St. Rose of Lima, or select that you are already a Parishioner. It may ask you to confirm a code with the Parish Office. If it does say this, give the Parish Office a call at 406-683-4391 to confirm your email and connect.

About Camino

The Diocese of Helena has been using this Camino program for a while to help Parish's connect with the Diocese and allow Parish's to easily keep track of Parish members and contributions. St. Rose of Lima has been using the program to keep contact information, household sizes and donor contribution information. This simplifies many tasks, including but not limited to: preparing labels for envelopes, keeping track of contributions and assigned envelope numbers, creating a Parish contact list, and creating tax letters for our Parishioners. The Camino Life app is brand new, and we would like to offer it as an easy way to update your household information. This app will also allow you to see your contribution history with St. Rose of Lima Parish and the Diocese of Helena. We of course will continue to have paper registration forms, but please consider using the Camino Life App so updates can be made quickly and correctly.

SUPPORT THOSE MOST IN NEED
