#### SACRAMENTAL LIFE

2. All those who are Baptized and have not yet completed the Sacrament of Confirmation are invited to register by calling or emailing the Parish Office.
3. Baptisms of children (0-6 years) Parents are required to attend class prior to the celebration of the Sacrament of Baptism of their 1st child.
4. The preparation for the Sacrament of Marriage lasts six months. If you are contemplating celebrating a wedding, please keep this in mind. Life is beautiful when the covenant is made forever before our Good Lord.

***Baptism:*** 6 years or Younger,

***First Communion:*** 7-19 Years of Age,

***Confirmation:*** 11-19 Years of Age

***OCIA:*** 18 years of Age or Older
